

To download a credential from www.nursys.com:

Castle requires proof of a current, active RN license to apply for your credential. www.nursys.com is a helpful website that offers nursing licensure confirmation that is quick, and easy to use.




To get started, click the blue "Search QuickConfirm" button in the middle box.




Read through the disclaimer, then click the "Continue" button at the bottom of the screen.

You will have the option to search by "Name" or "License Number"


To search by name, simply fill in the required fields, choose your license type and state, fill in the Captcha image text, and click the blue "search" button.



To search by license number, fill in the license number, choose your license type, and state, then fill in the Captcha image text and click the blue "Search" button.




Once your license has been found, you will be taken to a screen that looks like this:



Check the "License" box with for all licenses you wish to view. Then click the "Report" button.

You will be taken to a screen containing your QuickConfirm Report. To download your report, click the purple "Download Report" button.



You will be offered the option of "Report Only" or "Report with Documents". For our purposes, you need "Report Only"



Your report will download. Once it has been downloaded, it can be found in your "Downloads" folder on your computer. It will have a name such as "NURSYS_REPORT_8-29-2014_PDF". This is the file that will be uploaded into your application under RN License.

It will look something like this:
